2024 TALLINN OPEN Training Camp "Adding something new to your style"

TALLINN OPEN INTERNATIONAL WRESTLING TRAINING CAMP: The TALLINN OPEN training camp (March 25–27, 2024) is a unique high-level training opportunity which takes place at the competition site immediately following the tournament. The motto for the 2024 camp is "adding something new to your own style".

The 2023 Camp was attended by over 500 GR, FS and FW wrestlers of Schoolboy/girl, Cadet and Junior age from 21-countries. With such a wide diversity of wrestlers, the camp emphasises sparring, to maximise experience from different schools of wrestling, to help you add to your "own wrestling style". This is a vetted camp (not for beginners) and the number of participants is limited.

Training camp sessions are led by the various participating coaches. Every session is led by a coach of a different country. This is a popular and excellent opportunity for coaches and trainers to exchange ideas and gain experience from different schools of wrestling.

Overview:

- Camp is March 25-27, 2024 on 14-mats at the Competition Site.
- Two sessions per day
- Saunas, showers, facilities available
- Cost of camp is 22 eur/day. This includes 2-training sessions, facilities and two meals.
- Free transportation is provided by the City of Tallinn during the competition and training camp



Kristjan Palusalu is Estonia's most famous sports person, having won the Heavyweight Gold Medal at the 1936 Berlin Olympics in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle. Kristjan remains the only person to ever have achieved this feat at the same Olympic Games.

Young wrestlers have the opportunity to duplicate this feat, by participating in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle days.

In 2023 – three wrestlers accomplished this feat!

The TALLINN OPEN organising committee, is pleased to invite you to Europe's largest wrestling tournament, the 2024 TALLINN OPEN – KRISTJAN PALUSALU YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT in GR, FS and FW, from 22-24 march, 2024. The tournament is on 14-mats and employs the Nordic A/B system, guaranteeing a two-match minimum. It is possible to wrestle in both GR and FS on subsequent days. TALLINN OPEN is for experienced wrestlers. and is limited to 2200 wrestlers.

The 2023 TALLINN OPEN was attended by 2193 wrestlers (including 387 women) from 30-countries. Many National Teams use Tallinn Open for preparation or as a benchmark qualification tournament for European (Continental) and World Championships. The 2023 tournament attracted 40 national teams of various age-groups in GR, FS and FW. The 2023 protocol is here: www.liga-db.de/TallinnOpen2023

TALLINN OPEN is immediately followed by the International Wrestling Training Camp from March 25-27, 2024. In 2023 attracted over 500 GR, FS and FW wrestlers from 21-countries (please see Training Camp on page 4).

UNIBET ARENA Paldiski Maantee 104B, Tallinn 13522 www.unibetarena.ee (GPS coordinates: Lat: 59°42.6156′, Long E 24° 64.7332′). UNIBET ARENA is 10km from the Airport and Harbour, and 7km from the centre of the Old City.

REGISTRATION:

Registration via www.tallinnopen.ee "Registration Form" or email to info@tallinnopen.ee. Registration starts 1. september 2023. Registration ends either March 19, 2024 or at 2200 registered wrestlers, whichever comes first.

NOTE: In 2023, registration was closed weeks before start of competition, since maximum number of participants was reached.

REFEREE:

Experienced accredited referees are encouraged to participate. In 2023 there was 61 referees from 12-countries. Referees are provided accommodations and meals and compensated:

- 125eur per day for International Category referees
- 100eur per day for National Category referees

PARTICIPATION FEES:

Possibility to wrestle on both days.

- 25 euro Greco-Roman OR Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 30 eur.
- 35 euro Greco-Roman AND Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 40 eur.

An additional fee of 10 eur/wrestler is charged to those teams without a referee.

Taxi from harbour and airport to competition site is about 8-10 EUR. Bolt and Uber also operate in Tallinn.
